

PROOF OF RESIDENCY	
<p>In order to register a resident student, the parent, legal guardian or the student shall provide proof of residency or proof that waiver has been requested as outlined below and shall complete all admission requirements as determined by Local Board policies, rules and regulations. Resident students who cannot provide adequate proof of residency may request a waiver in accordance with state law. Students who do not meet residency requirements may apply for admission in accordance with state law regarding admission of nonresident students (see Board Policy 2240).</p>	
<p>At least one (1) of the following criteria shall be used in determining student residency:</p>

The domicile of a minor child shall be the domicile of a parent or court-appointed legal guardian. <input type="checkbox"/> The student has otherwise proven to be legally domiciled within the district. 	
<p>In order to satisfy the district's residency requirements, the student, parent or court-appointed legal guardian must provide one (1) or more of the following items as proof of residency:</p>
